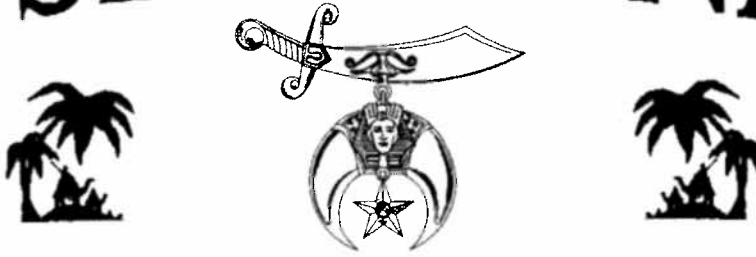
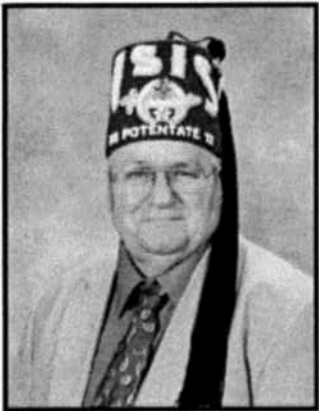

Summer Days

What a strange year weather-wise! First we had no winter and now it's only mid-May with harvest just days away. We are almost in the lazy-crazy days of summer.

As a boy growing up on the farm, our dad kept us pretty busy but every so often it would rain - now that's something we haven't seen in awhile. A rainy day when I was a kid could go in two completely opposite directions ranging from roquing a milo field of cockleburs or cleaning the chicken house to goofing-off with my friends in town or simply going fishing.

Most of my early fishing trips were with my Dad and Uncle Bill. These were generally to one of our farm ponds where we always fished for catfish. It seemed that catching fish was easy, but finding them could be a real problem. Two or three times a summer we would spend a day noodling (hand fishing) for flathead catfish on the Solomon River, a few miles down the road from our house. In the hot summers, the river would get really low, leaving deeper potholes of water below huge logjams. We'd walk from hole to hole sometimes ending up miles from the vehicle.

As I look back, I can see God's work while fishing up and down the river. No matter how much rain or how little, those catfish always survived. The washed out areas and potholes always held just enough water for the fish to get by in even the hottest and driest summer. As those catfish are important to God, so are we important to Him. He'll never let us run out of water no matter how tough times are.

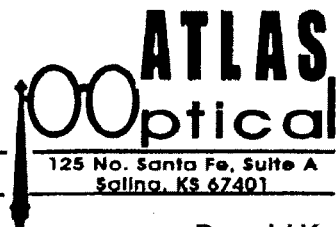
I don't suppose those catfish ever worry about the river drying up. That's called **faith** and it's the basis for **everything** we will ever be.

My dad and uncle are both gone now, but the memories of those days growing up are priceless. Whether I take a day off to fish with a friend or spend the day cleaning the chicken house with my brother, the real joy in life comes from the fellowship we share with the people we love, and the faith we place in the One who provides our every need.

WHO'S WHO IN THE ISIS LEGION OF HONOR

The Isis Shrine Legion of Honor would like to honor the veterans who are members of this organization.

For the month of May we will honor John Alexander Province, Jr. John was born December 23, 1923 in Salina, Kansas. In 1941 he joined the Navy and spent boot camp at the Great Lakes.



John was sent to the east coast and was assigned to the 2nd Beach Battalion. He was assigned to the underwater demolition group. They trained with the Army Rangers and Commandos. Today they are known as the *Navy Seals* or "frog men".

During the invasion of Sicily, Italy, John's demolition group was assigned to remove all obstacles that prevented the landing crafts from coming ashore. Because of numerous injuries and loss of men, the group was re-assigned to the 6th Beach Battalion. He was discharged in November 1946.

John went to work at Quinton Duffen Optical Company in Salina, Kansas until 1950 when the Korean War broke out. He reenlisted in the Navy and was assigned to the battleship U.S.S. Missouri. He did 2 tours of duty in Korea. He was discharged in September 1954 after serving 10 years, 4 months, 27 days in the Navy.

He married Loree McDowell on May 2, 1992.

John joined the Salina Blue Lodge in 1958 and Isis Shrine in 2005. He has been a member of the Legion of Honor for 3 years.

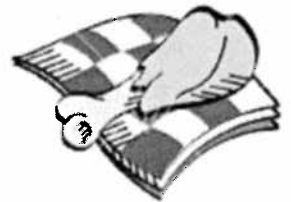

The Kansas Shrine Bowl is only three months away! If you need any information at this point or have any questions at all do not hesitate to call the Shrine Bowl office at 800-530-5524.

The Shriners ticket packet will show up in your mailbox very soon, if it hasn't already. Any donation you can make to our mission to benefit the Shriners Hospitals for Children is much appreciated. There are a few new elements to the ticket packet including the 110% Club and Patient Ambassador Sponsorships. Please note that as you are reading through the packet this year.

For the first time ever, the Kansas Shrine Bowl is offering an ad sales commission program benefiting clubs and units of the salesman's choice. Individuals may earn 15% of their new commercial program sales and 10% on renewals for a designated Shrine Club or Unit. If an individual or group of Nobles generates \$1,000 [roughly 4 full page ads] in commercial sales, they can earn \$150.00 for their designated club or unit. If the same \$1,000.00 is renewed, \$100.00 will be generated. The Kansas Shrine Bowl Board of Directors noticed that most clubs and units use their funds for Temple projects or support the kids and Shriners Hospitals for Children. Much of that is sent through the Kansas Shrine Bowl in the form of sponsorships or Gold Pages, so this will be a "win-win" program for all concerned.

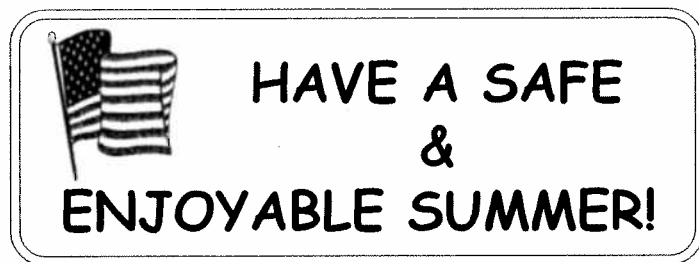
